A Wheelchair Story



On Monday evening, October 30, Ken and I drove to D'Iberville, Mississippi to pick up ten wheelchairs from a contact who has been supplying us with mobility equipment for three years at a low cost.

To our amazement, 17 wheelchairs, 4 rollators, 2 canes, 1 pair of C arm crutches (a critical need) and a box of footrests were donated to the Wheelchair Ministry. After the equipment was loaded, the gentleman continued to tell us what his wife told him that morning.

She said, "I wonder who the wheelchairs are helping. I picture a short Indian woman in traditional clothing in a wheelchair with a smile on her face." His wife was familiar with the Latin American culture, because she had lived in Mexico for a short time.

Having brought FRIDLA's newsletter with me, I gave it to the man and said, "Here is a picture of the woman your wife is talking about."

He responded excitedly, "I have got to show this to my wife."

She read and smiled knowingly when she saw the picture. The quote from the newsletter said, "The lady is dressed in the typical clothing and hat of the Quechua people"

As the man walked us to our car, we prayed for him and his wife, exchanged hugs, and left with joyful hearts. Our faith was in awe at the conversation that took place and how God had worked in the details of that evening allowing us to engage this couple in a meaningful way.
