

... but it feels like the party can't really begin until the other guests arrive!

As we make our way through the gospel of Luke this month, we'll see that truth over and over again in the Christmas narratives. Luke seems to be telling us, "It's not really Christmas until all the guests arrive!" When Mary sang the Magnificat, her amazing song of God's faithfulness, she wasn't alone! According to Luke, she was with her cousin Elizabeth. (Luke 1:39-56) When John the Baptist was born, Luke tells us, "Now the time came for Elizabeth to give birth, and she bore a son And her neighbors and relatives heard that the Lord had shown great mercy to her, and they rejoiced with her." (Luke 1:57-58) When Jesus was born, his birth was celebrated by "a multitude of the heavenly host." (Luke 2:13) When the shepherds heard the good news, they all went to Bethlehem together! (Luke 2:15-16)

This month, we're going to be celebrating Christmas – the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. That celebration begins on Sunday, December 2nd, with the first Sunday of Advent. PRAYING FOR OUR PINEWOODS MISSIONARIES

Please Pray that Christ's Kingdom Will Come Throughout the World.

Missionary Visit -- Robert and Jeanne Smith have been with MTW as second-career missionaries since 2011, serving in Riga, Latvia. While their primary focus is church-planting, they have been involved in children, teen and college-aged ministry as well as evangelism and discipleship to ladies and men. Facilitating the publication of Christian literature in Latvian has also been part of their work. Robert serves as a ruling elder in the current church-plant which celebrated its 2nd anniversary in September 2018. This church has grown from 11 adults to over 40 adults, and



almost as many children! Both Robert and Jeanne lead singing in worship as well as church hospitality. Currently, they are praying with Latvians and seeking God about another Reformed church-plant in the next 2 years, possibly in a different area of Riga or another Latvian city, and are looking for team members to join them in this adventure.

They will be <u>visiting Pinewoods on Sunday</u>, <u>January 13</u>, when they will speak in Sunday School, Community Life, and a Life Group.

Chuck and Wyema – sensitive ministry

Pray for Chuck, who had to be hospitalized with infection in the ICU after having open heart surgery. Pray for his complete recovery.

Duane and Kim Baxter – Christian Medical Ministry of South Alabama

Pray for staff and students who will go on a medical mission trip to Costa Rica Dec. 15-21. This will include all kinds of healthcare students, providers, and spouses.

Pray for all to understand more fully the compassion of Christ, and for some patients to come to faith.

Ben and Andrea -sensitive ministry

Praise God for the beginnings of an Arabic language program connecting believers with this opportunity to learn the heart language of those to whom they are ministering. At the higher levels, students will study the Bible with their Muslim tutors.

Ben recently visited and prayed with Y., who had surgery in early November to remove a cancerous tumor below his eye. Please pray for complete healing, and for his salvation (and that of his family)!

Two of M.'s children have started having an unusual reaction during regular blood transfusions. It made me (Andrea) think of Heb. 5:7-9. We read the passage, then talked about crying out to God in our prayers like Jesus did. She also read that He is the source of salvation for all who obey Him. After we prayed together, she sat and thought for a while about it. Please pray for her salvation and also pray that God would heal her kids.

As a team member and I recently studied the Bible with N., her parents, and older brother, her dad read the passage explaining each line in every day Arabic. All so engaged, they wrestled with the truths that came up. I thought, "Lord, may this continue" - where her dad reads from the Bible and discusses it with his family - but may they all believe it is truth and obey it! They want to read stories about Jesus with us regularly. Please pray for this family.

A group of men involved with the Bible study is having trouble coordinating their schedules. Please pray that this would be a priority to these men and that each of them would hunger to study with Ben and our team members.

Jon and Teresa Simons – SIMA missionaries assigned to Colombia, studying in Australia

The kids will be starting at a bilingual (English/Spanish) school next year. This school may help them transition back to Colombia, and give them some fun experiences.

Jon's advisor from the UK came for a week. It was a good time to assess the progress made so far on his doctoral work, and determine the trajectory for the future. It was so encouraging to see that he is ahead of schedule, as he has finished what they expected him to have done around June of 2019.

Clay and Darlene Quarterman – MTW missionaries in Kiev, Ukraine

Although Evangelical Seminary of Ukraine will soon occupy its own building, they still haven't sold their OLD OFFICE! They hope to be in our new location by spring of next year, but they need the funds from the sale of their old office! So please help them SELL IT -- BY PRAYER!! They raised the roof on the new building to accommodate ten more dorm students. Although they are on Home Ministry Assignment this year, Clay returned to Kiev in May to teach an intensive course on *Church and Ministry*.



They also celebrated the graduation of Alexei Bliznyuk, who has been accepted for further studies in the Netherlands, at Kampen University. He is recently married and serves the Reformed church.

They're working toward self-support to NATIONALIZE the seminary, and their new building will be a large part of that. But the seminary will need DONORS -- one-time and ongoing donors -- as the churches grow toward self-support. Their **national Board of Directors** met in May, and all were very pleased at their commitment to their roles and responsibilities.



Several of our graduates are getting degrees in the West and returning to teach in ERSU seminary.

Some of them are already writing and publishing.

It sometimes takes years to see others join the work in this region. They are thankful to be positioned to help these families and others who work in the interior.

You may remember that a Cherokee 6 aircraft came to Mark in pieces and he has been putting it back together. A final paint job will make it ready for service. He will also do maintenance and inspections on a number of other airplanes, other vehicles and a tractor. SEND's Cessna 206 needed maintenance, so Mark could not fly as many children to Bible camps this last summer.

When Daddy's a missionary pilot, Grandpa made Orson his own tiny plane! The tail number, N68ISA, is for Isaiah 6:8: "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? and who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!""

Rev. Chad Turner RUF at Valdosta State University




He likes to say he is married to his best friend, and that he married way up! Chad and Kristen are proud to have two boys, two girls and another one on the way.
